








Old Things Made New







US churches help sew life-changing dome covers

Family doctors Anita and Rick Gutierrez train and equip "Health Builders" in South Africa to combat lifestyle-related diseases such as HIV/AIDS, high blood pressure, heart and artery disease, diabetes, and malaria. Health Builders also receive training in fruit tree propagation, gardening, and poultry skills to help them promote good nutrition, generate income, and lead Bible study groups in their communities.

Do you know what a geodesic dome is? This group from the American Baptist Churches of Rhode Island (pictured above) helped build one recently while learning how we and our partners use them to raise chickens, grow fruit trees, and provide meeting spaces in our ministry in South Africa. Members of the group also sewed a shade cover for a dome that we will bring back with us to South Africa to use as part of this ministry.

Recently, I have been working with American Baptist Women's groups and churches in Michigan, Kansas, and Colorado, to conduct these two to three hour workshops. I supply the group with enough materials to make 1.5 dome covers. If they want to make more they will spend about \$80 to purchase another bolt of shade cloth, and they will then have enough to sew another 1.5 covers, or three in total. My goal is to have groups make about twenty of these covers a year, which we will ship back in luggage ourselves or short-term mission groups can bring them. **Each cover a group makes saves me about two complete days of labor. The covers will last for fifteen years and provide true value to cost. As I am involved with health work in addition to this agricultural and economic capacity-building work, time saved on making these covers is time available for other parts of our mission.** All dome parts are cut by hand by myself, as are covers. It takes me two days to cut all the parts for a tunnel dome and two days to measure, cut, and stitch the thirty triangles of the dome shade cloth into a complete cover. It costs me eighty days of labor to make twenty per year, which means about 1/3 of my time is spent just cutting domes and making covers.

These tunnel domes become places for life to flourish and create green space, shade, and trees for present and future South Africans, Mozambicans and Swazis. That is what this is about—priming the pump for human flourishing and showing people a skill with trees which does change their lives.

We thank all those churches who are participating in these workshops, and providing us with dome covers! We are so grateful to God for the ways in which your partnership makes these ministries of new life possible.


